

# New centrifugal stations for the Uelzen and Wierthe sugar factories



BMA has received an order from Nordzucker AG for the supply of ten new type B1750 batch centrifugals. All machines will come complete with drive and the new BMA control system. Five of these machines will be operated in the Uelzen plant for the production of refined sugar. The two remaining old centrifugals will under the same order be equipped with the new control system.

In Wierthe, all the old centrifugals of the white-sugar centrifugal station will be replaced by five B1750 machines. The two previously supplied machines of the same type will then be used for refined sugar. These machines, too, will be equipped with the new BMA control system. Once the new machines have been installed, the complete white-sugar station will have machines of the same type throughout.

The main reason for Nordzucker to decide for BMA centrifugals was the technological reason. In addition, this decision will allow Nordzucker to increase the level of standardization and to cut overall cost, including cost for spare parts stock, maintenance and service.
